**JUNE LONG WEEKEND CAMP** (June 8th to 10th) - generally we can arrive from Thursday Afternoon (the toilets need digging!!) and depart Monday afternoon.

Directions for getting there:

Travel to Jerrys Plains (less than an hour from Newcastle). At this point you can choose two different ways to go.

a) Take the Jones Reserve Road to the Martindale Road junction and turn right. After 200m turn left into Yarrawa Development Road and over Kings Gap. Turn left into Sandy Hollow-Bylong Road and travel 5km to the Baerami Creek Road turn-off.

Or

b) from Jerrys Plains continue on to Denman and then towards Sandy Hollow. Turn left into Sandy Hollow-Bylong Road and proceed to Baerami Creek Road turn-off.

Then turn left into Baerami Creek Road and travel for 25km (do not take the Hungerford Road which is 12 km from the Baerami Creek Road turn-off) then take the track to the right for 1.5km to the Shale Oil Retort and continue for about another 1.5km. You will be in national park.

Camp in the area near the beginning of the Reubens Fire Trail.

For those who prefer to use GPS the approximate coordinates for the start of the Reubens Fire Trail are as follows: -32.557701, 150.440304 (32°33'27.7"S 150°26'25.1"E)

Note that you will traverse private property for the final 3km over unsealed track. There are no facilities so bring all your own water and take home all your rubbish. HBOC will provide toilet etc.
